Help Guide - Outdoor Cabinet Layout

Sketch out the walls, columns and cabinet in this space.

1. Start by drawing all the walls and columns in the intended space to install the outdoor cabinets. Mark locations and sizes of windows and doors. Do the windowsills protrude out further than the wall?
2. Draw the footprint of the cabinets and where they will meet the walls and columns. Identify walls and cabinets with labels.
3. Mark locations of electrical, plumbing, gas and any objects that will be behind or under where the cabinets will be installed. Be sure to record both horizontal and vertical dimensions of every object. Take photos of obstructions for reference.
4. Are there any obstructions that will prevent cabinet from being placed in position and resting against the wall and floor?
5. Does the cabinet need to go through a door? What is the door size? Are there stairs or other obstacles that will be challenging to get cabinets to the final location?
6. Add dimensions to everything, clearly mark dimension to heights, widths and lengths of both walls and cabinets. Measure opening where cabinets will be installed at the floor to the back of the cabinet and the front of the cabinet, also measure 36" from floor at the back and the front of the cabinet. Identifying locations and model numbers of all components ie., grills, refrigerators and sinks. Record direction of desired door swings, ensuring obstructions are not a factor.
7. Lastly, use the final build drawing we provide to verify every size and detail before approving.
